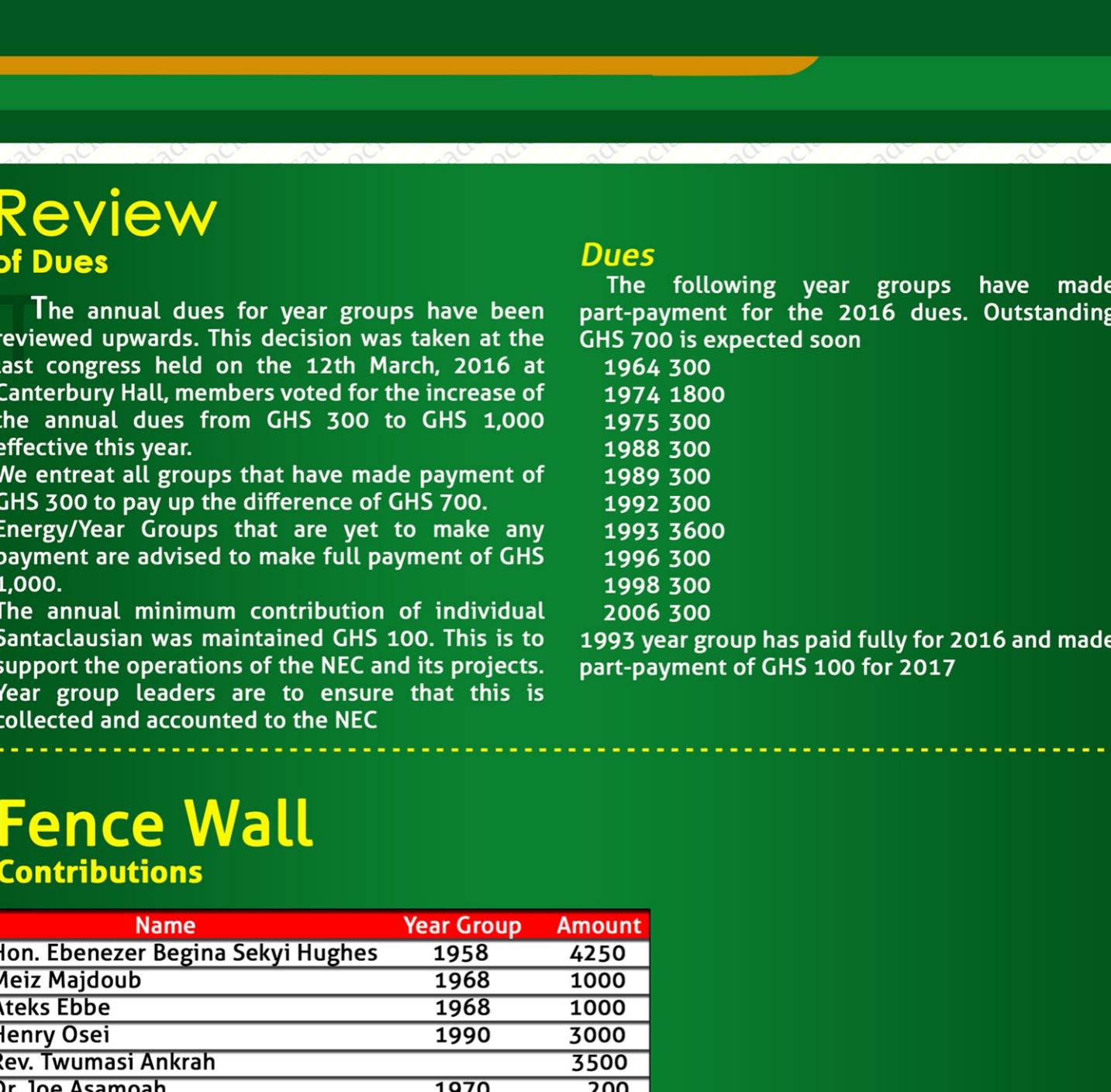

Review of Dues

Decongestion of the School

We are delighted to inform you that as at Tuesday 15th, March 2016 the Chapel has ceased to be a classroom.

The NEC is working with all stakeholders to reduce congestion at the school.

Efforts are being made to reclaim the classrooms converted to dormitories soon.

The last two games has however seen the competition changed to be competed between Leopoldville and Katanga. The first of the series of games was won by Katanga 8-4 in December last year.

On the 5th of March, 2016 the Katanga team led by yours truly Solomon Allotey not deterred by the heavy rains faced the so called might of the Leopoldville team led by the pot bellied and bald David Kattah. Katanga fielded a crack team of highly skilled players notably Hon. George Opare Addo, Ode for Akwapem South as our goal keeper, Solomon Allotey as captain, Alex Abrokwah, Godron Atsunyo etc to face kattah and his imported professionals. AGLIONBY HOUSE RENOVATIONS

*To all Aglionbyites
As a result of your generosity in 2010 a call went out to you to help renovate the great house which was then in a rather sorry state. Photos of facilities in the house at the time shocked the wider Santaclaustian community. As a result of your generosity both financially and materially the job was done under the lead of Mr Kwasi Kutin, former House Prefect. Recently you've also been generous with contributions towards the repainting of the house, again supervised by Mr Kutin. The pride of students, THE LOCKERS, are now needing replacing. They have served their time very well for 40 years but are now unusable in the main.

Once again, Mr Kutin is on the case. He has personally funded and renovated a slab of 6 lockers and partially renovated another slab using money left over from the repainting exercise. Please see the 'before' and 'after' photos. Could you please adopt a 6-Locker Slab either personally or with others? This will cost GH\$ 1600, and a total of GH\$ 28,000 will be needed to renovate all the remaining lockers. In the USA, make payments through the Adisadel Foundation. - APPRECIATION:**
Management is grateful to the president of NEC of AOBNA as well as all AOBNA both at Home and the Diaspora and other stakeholders for their continuous support.
- VACATION AND REOPENING:**
College vacated for the Lent Holidays on 23rd March, 2016.
Reopening for the Trinity Term is Monday 18th April, 2016.
- WASSCE 2016:**
The exams commenced on Monday 22nd February, 2016 with Practicals and Project works and will end on 13th May, 2016. Final year students stayed in school during the vacation to study and write the Exam.
- CASURE OF CLASSES AT ST. NICHOLAS CHAPEL AND CANTERBURY HALL:**
Classes at the chapel and Canterbury Hall were stopped just after the Speech Day and refurbishment of the 2 facilities are in progress.
- DISCIPLINARY ACTION ON STUDENTS:**
Just before vacation, about 47 students mostly Final Year students were sanctioned by the Disciplinary Committee in collaboration with the Board of Governors sub-Committee on Discipline for various offences.
- RECONSTITUTION OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS:**
Plans are far advanced for inauguration of the College's new Board of Governors because the tenure of the Old Board of Governors has expired.
- DONATION OF SPORTS EQUIPMENTS:**
A 1968 Year Group Santaclaustian, Dr. Amaoko Attah donated assorted sports equipments to our Alma Mater as his contribution to promote sports, on Wednesday, 13th April, 2016.
- DISSOLUTION OF TWO NEW HOUSES:**
In pursuance of action to decongest the over population in the College, and further claim the classrooms converted into Dormitories, the 2 new Houses, One and Two, have been dissolved by management. All Forms 2 and 1 students of the two Houses have been shared on to the 10 Existing Houses of the College, and on the average each House absorbed 26 students.
- NEWLY COMMISSIONED 1991 YEAR GROUP SICK BAY:**
The facility is incomplete and the medical staff have submitted a tall list of requirements that would enhance the completion and usage of the Infirmary.
- OFFICE VEHICLE FOR THE HEADMASTER:**
