Strategic Plan/Land Use

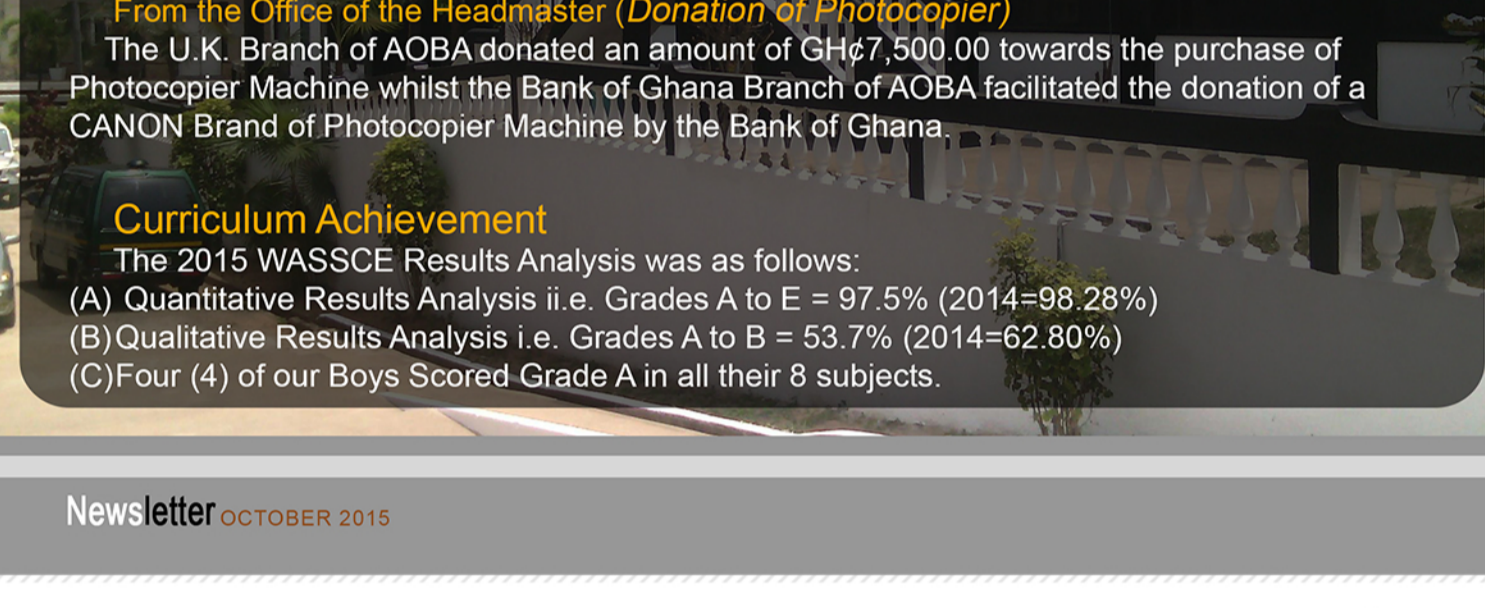

 (C) Four (4) of our Boys Scored Grade A in all their 8 subjects.



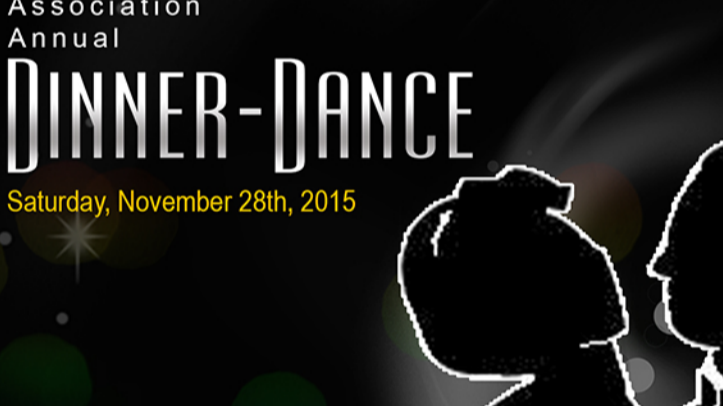
Santa-MOBA Games
